General behaviour

- Members should be caring, kind and polite
Treat others with respect
Help and support your society members and wider community
Do not impose your opinion on others
Keep an open mind and avoid arguing over differences of opinion

Financial Conduct

- The Society will promote honest, ethical and open behaviour in all financial dealings

Meetings

- Group meetings should be harassment-free and respectful
- The Chairperson (or Vice-Chair) will open the meeting and welcome everyone to the meeting
- Be respectful when others are speaking
- Listen to each other and be polite
- Use respectful language

Discrimination

- No member will discriminate against any other member of the Society or public
- Bad language and prejudice is not acceptable
- Treat others with respect

Confidentiality

- Members should keep personal or private information confidential - and will not publicly discuss anything that might shame or upset an individual

Breach of Code of Conduct and appeal procedure

- If a member does not abide by these rules, the Society leads will speak with them and ask them not to repeat the behaviour. Continued breaches may result in them being asked to leave the Society
